

A comparative study of home environment between male sports persons and female sports persons

The level of significance was set at 0.05. we find out that there is not significant difference between male sports person and female sports person in their home environment.

Table 1. Shows that 't' value (0.91). The mean score of male sports and female sports person is lower than the table value 0.05. The mean score of female sports person (224.80) is higher than the male sports person (224.80), but not

significant at 0.05 level. It means that there is not significantly difference between female sports person and male sports person in their home environment.

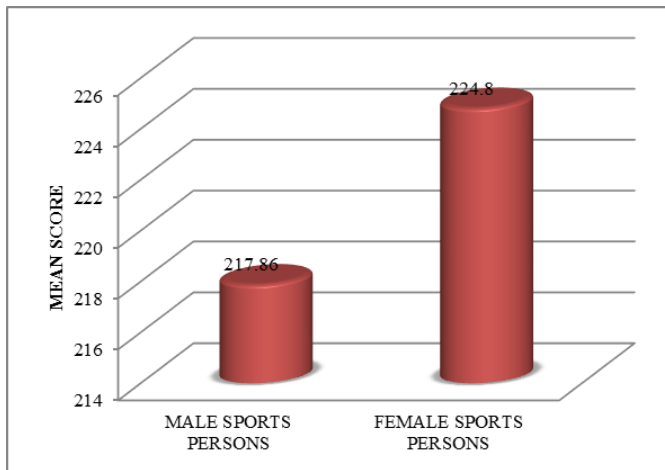


Fig 1: Mean difference between male sports and female sports person in their home environment
